

Who is Sigma Pi Alpha Sorority, Inc?

Sigma Pi Alpha Sorority, Inc. is a Chicana/Latina based sorority that was founded in 1996 at the University of California, Berkeley. What is The Sigma Pi Alpha Sorority, Inc. Scholarship Fund?

The Sigma Pi Alpha Sorority, Inc. Scholarship Fund was created to award women with the same dedication to academics and our community as the sisters of Sigma Pi Alpha Sorority, Inc. Sigma Pi Alpha Sorority, Inc. will provide the top one (1) applicant with a scholarship of \$500 and the next nine (9) runner-up applicants will receive a scholarship of \$300.

Eligibility

- Female **High School Senior** with a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Will attend a **community college or a four-year institution** in the fall semester of 2024.
- U.S. Citizenship or Permanent Residency <u>is not a requirement</u> for this scholarship and <u>will not</u> be considered during the application review.

Selection – Applications are evaluated on the following:

- Academic Achievement (including GPA, Awards, Honors)
- Two Letters of Recommendation (from a teacher, supervisor, advisor, etc.) but not from a family member or friend (REQUIRED)
- Personal Statement

Your Application Packet Must Include:

- 1. One Official Transcript including all academic grades through Fall Semester of 2023.
- 2. A Letter of Recommendation addressing the following:
 - a. Current academic status.
 - b. Academic and extracurricular achievements.
 - c. Personal qualities such as motivation, leadership and commitment.
 - d. Potential for future success

3. A Letter of Recommendation addressing the following:

- a. Community service involvement within your community.
- b. Any volunteer participation throughout high school.
- c. Contributions to your community.
- d. Any organization or community based internship involvement.

4. A typed three-pages double-spaced Personal Statement in which you address:

- a. Heritage (family background, parentage, etc.)
- b. Personal and academic achievements, giving specific examples.
- c. Academic plans and career goals, giving specific examples.
- d. Past and current efforts, as well as future plans, toward making a difference in your community.
- e. Financial needs to pursue a higher education.

- 2. Winning recipients' notifications will be sent out: June 3rd 2024
- 3. Winning recipients will receive a letter and email.
